B.Sc., (Nursing) – 4 Years ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Application Form

Application form and Prospectus can be obtained from the Office / Downloaded from our college website (annammalnursingcollege.com) on payment of cash or through G-pay

Eligibility

- ▶ The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
- ▶ Minimum Educational Qualification
 - * Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually.
 - * In respect of candidates to SC/ST/OBC the marks obtained in 3 core subjects shall be 40 % instead of 45% for General candidates.
 - * Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only.
 - * English is a compulsory subject in 12th Standard Examination for being eligible for admission to B.Sc(N).
- ▶ Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates.
- ▶ Candidate shall be medically fit. Medical Fitness Certificate will be provided from our Chief Medical Officer after the completion of Medical Examination done in our parent (Annammal) Hospital
- ▶ Married candidates are also eligible for admission.
- ▶ Students shall be admitted once in a year.
- ▶ Selection of candidates should be based on the merit of the entrance examination. Entrance test** shall comprise of:
 - a) Aptitude for Nursing 20 marks
 - b) Physics 20 marks
 - c) Chemistry 20 marks
 - d) Biology 20 marks
 - e) English 20 marks

▶ The minimum qualifying criteria of entrance test to admission to B.Sc. Nursing is as under: General 50th percentile, SC/ST/OBC 40th percentile, General - PwD 45th percentile, SC/ST/OBC - PwD 40th percentile

*** Entrance test shall be conducted by university / State Government

Submission of Application

The intending candidate must submit their application in the prescribed form to the Principal, Annammal College of Nursing, Kuzhithurai.

Xerox copies of the following documents should be enclosed with the application form:

- Mark Sheet of Secondary School leaving Certificate and +2 (or) equivalent
- 5 copies of duly attested passport size photographs.
- Conduct certificate from Head of the Institution, where in the applicant studied for his /her qualifying examination.
- Migration certificate should be submitted, if the student is from out of state of Tamilnadu.
- Community Certificate
- Transfer Certificate
- Covid Vaccination Certificate
- Hepatitis B Vaccination Certificate
- Application with incomplete information and not accompanied by documents required as above will be rejected.
- Candidates called for the interview should bring with them all the above certificates and mark sheets in original.
- Candidate who have appeared for examination other than Tamilnadu State Board Examination have to produce to produce an Eligibility Certificate from the Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai.
- The eligible SC/ST, OBC, PWD student should submit their scholarship form for the academic year by February for processing scholarship to SC/ST, OBC, PWD students each year.

Mode of Selection

A list of eligible candidates in order of merit will be prepared by the College Selection Committee on the basis of +2 marks and interview of the candidates.

The unfilled vacancies remaining after the cut off date will be filled up with candidates in the list so prepared in order of merit.

- » The Payment of College & Hostel fees
- » Submission of Eligibility Certificate
